DMV will mail the paperwork and fees to VDGIF for processing and DMV will issue a 90 day temporary registration, DMV does not issue the actual registration or Certificate of Title to a Vessel. (Note: DMV does not accept mail-in applications for Boat Registrations and Titles).

## What documents do I need to submit with the application?

## New Watercraft

- Original Manufacturer's or Importer's Certificate of Origin, with the "First Assignment" portion completed by the dealer.
- Sales invoice showing gross purchase price of the boat and motor separate from the trailer, and any sales tax paid.

Home Built Boat (Note: Your watercraft may be subject to inspection by a law enforcement officer.)

- Affidavit for Registering and Titling a Boat not Previously Registered and/or Titled **
- Copies of receipts for building materials.
- Pictures of the entire boat from all sides (front, transom, both sides of vessel bow to stern)

## Titled in Virginia
