The Northampton County Electoral Board met on Thursday, December 2, 2021 in the Voter Registration Office in Eastville.

The meeting was called to order by the Chair at 10:35 A.M. A moment of silence was observed.

The minutes of the Electoral Board meeting on November 3, 2021, having been reviewed by the Board were approved and signed.

Board and registrar conducted a brief review of the November 2, 2021 general and Special Elections. No issues were found that would require fixing for future elections. The different CAP process, with three reporting categories and SOR's was discussed as well.

Board and registrar discussed upcoming legislation in the General Assembly. Registrar discussed legislation that would help strengthen voter privacy. There was also a discussion concerning if same day registration at the polling place on Election Day would be enacted.

It should be noted that this was the last meeting for JoAnne Fitchett, whose appointed term expires at the end of December. Ms. Fitchett was a staunch advocate for fair, free and accurate elections for all voters for six years, and her voice of reason and common sense will be missed, as will her sense of humor and compassion.
